Items of interest from the Borough: The deer kill is ongoing and will continue through hunting season. Wayman Park is one of the hunt zones. Be advised, interfering with this type of operation is against the law. You may direct any questions or concerns to the Borough Chief of Police.

New language has been adopted to the ordinance governing the storage of refuse and recycling containers. Change as follows: "With the exception of pickup days when the containers are placed for collection; garbage, rubbish, and recycling containers shall be properly stored behind the front face of the building and shall be screened from view of the street. Borough issued refuse and recycling containers may be placed against the building for storage as determined by the Code Enforcement Officer if physical conditions including irregularity, narrowness, or shallowness of lot size or shape or exceptional topography or other physical conditions to the property make it impossible to meet location and screening requirements.

Please remember that here in Steeplechase all refuse and recycling containers must be stored inside our units.

Whitehall pool is really taking shape. The final section of the retaining wall has been completed and roofing is ongoing for the concession building, pump room and ticket booth.




