Spring will be here before we know it and this is a good time to review the Steeplechase pet policies. The Steeplechase policies were incorporated directly from the **Whitehall Borough's Animal Ordinance.**

- Dogs and cats are not permitted to run at large within the Borough of Whitehall or other people's property.
- Pet owners shall not allow their animal to soil, defile, defecate on any property in Whitehall Borough or any private property.
- All dogs must be licensed and have current inoculations
- Pets may not be tied outside and be able to reach another person's property.
- Owners must clean up immediately after their pets.
- Owners should not permit pets to urinate on trees, shrubs and plants in common areas.
- The Board reserves the right to require that pets be removed from the Community in the event the pet causes a nuisance such as continual barking, biting, and/or destruction of property. Instances of failure to comply will be reported to Whitehall Borough for appropriate action.
- This policy applies to all animals visiting the community.

Boro Ordinance

§ 71.5. Violations and penalties: [Amended 4-6-83 by Ord. No. 663] Any person or persons violating the provisions hereof shall, in addition to the charge of five dollars (\$5.) per day for impoundment and detention, be guilty of a summary offense and, upon conviction thereof before a District Justice, shall be liable to the maximum penalties permitted by law.




