Hello Everyone

Spring ... Busy, Busy, Busy

I'll talk about our projects in a minute; but, first, I want to acknowledge all the fabulous people who dedicate their time and talents to the Community. We could never accomplish what we do without them. Periodically, I meet with board members from other communities and I've yet to find any that measures even halfway close to Steeplechase. THANK YOU to the Board members, Committee Chairs, people who work on committees, people who staff the Steeplechase Hotline, people who volunteer for Helping Hands. You make us who we are.

Projects:

<u>Lampposts</u>: We currently have 46 lampposts in the community. The Board has approved replacing 41 of those and adding two new ones. Five lampposts on Lantern Hill Extension are in good shape and do not need to be replaced. We will, however, add new lamp heads to those poles. The Board also approved adding two new lampposts along LHE in very dark areas. The contract for this work has been awarded to M&J Electrical Contracting, Inc. The total cost of the project will be \$242,195, plus any additional items that might arise. The materials have been ordered and work will commence shortly. This project will be paid for with funds in our Reserve & Replacement Fund. THANK YOU to everyone who worked on this project.

<u>Steeplechase Welcome Sign</u>: John Paravati suggested the Board consider a "Welcome to Steeplechase" sign at the Steeplechase property line along Caste. The Board approved and the sign is being prepared.

<u>Landscaping</u>: Once again, John Paravati has done a great job working with the Landscaper in designing upgrades for several areas. As I write, this is a work in progress. THANK YOU, John.

Annual Inspection: Board members are ready to begin the annual inspection. Each Inspector will do inspections at his/her convenience. We will continue to do follow-up inspections each month.

If you receive a letter, please don't ignore it. If you dispute what you are being asked to do, or if you find that you are not able to complete the maintenance work within the time specified, please let us know. If you just ignore the letter, it will ultimately lead to fines. No one wants that to happen.

Thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation. Please don't hesitate to call us if you have any questions or concerns. We will be happy to work with you to get these problems resolved.

Recycle Toters: OH THANK YOU! THANK YOU! To Debbie Barone. She persisted and got through to Waste Management and got them to agree to allow residents to request trading in the 64 gal recycle toter for a 35 gal one. Donations: As we do every year, the Board approved a \$1,000 donation to the Whitehall Fire Company and \$350 to MRTSA.


